SATURDAY, OCTOBER 13

- Arrive in Vilnius

SUNDAY, OCTOBER 14

- Visit Trakai, the historical capital city of Lithuania, where you will learn about the Karaites, a sect of Jews who served as bodyguards to the Grand Duke of Lithuania
- Tour of Vilnius
- Dinner with members of the Jewish community

MONDAY, OCTOBER 15

- Visit the Vilnius Shalom Aleichem ORT School and meet staff, students, parents and alumni
- Visit the Jewish Tolerance Museum
- Fly to Kiev

TUESDAY, OCTOBER 16

- Visit the Kiev ORT Educational Complex #141 and meet staff, students, parents and alumni
- Visit the ORT-Hillel Educational Center
- Together with students from the ORT Educational Complex, visit Babi-Yar, site of one of the largest massacres during the Holocaust
- Tour of Kiev
- Dinner with members of the Jewish community

WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 17

- Visit both campuses of the Simcha Jewish Educational Complex and meet staff, students, parents and alumni
- Tour of Kiev
- Depart Kiev for Israel; arrive in Tel Aviv

- Visit Kfar Hassidim Youth Village and Kiryat Yam

- Visit the Tel Aviv Museum of Art and meet the head of art restoration
- Welcome dinner

- Visit one of Israel's Air Force bases (tbc)

- Walk to Ben-Gurion House, the residence of the first prime minister, David Ben-Gurion. After a tour, meet Moshe Ben-Eliezer, grandson of this visionary leader

- Visit Beer Sheva Technological College and Dimona YOUiversity and meet students
- Guided observation of the Gaza Strip from Netiv Ha'asara, a village in the northwestern Negev, and briefing from the former advisor to the Israeli Coordination and Liaison Administration to the Gaza Strip
- Visit Sderot and a synagogue damaged by a rocket launched from Gaza
- Farewell dinner hosted by residents of Sderot
